Application for Interment

When applying for approval to inter cremated remains you will need to complete the Trust's documentation and pay the relevant fees. Cremated remains are interred in perpetuity, there is no tenure, so no further fees are payable after the interment.

Planning Ahead

Many families choose to benefit by planning ahead and securing positions at current prices in a not-for-profit community cemetery. This gives them peace of mind knowing that requests will be honoured and family members will be saved from making difficult decisions at an emotional time.

Reservations can be made for burial plots and sites for the interment of cremated remains/ashes.

Ashes Interment and Memorialisation Options

Wodonga Cemetery offers a range of attractive interment options for your loved one including Ashes Gardens and Monumental Sites. Monument and lawn burial sites can be used for the interment of ashes.

Wodonga Cemetery provides plaques but does not arrange headstones . Please contact our office for a list of stonemasons who are authorised to carry out these works in the Wodonga Cemetery.

The Wodonga Cemetery is managed by the Wodonga Cemetery Trust which is made up of a group of Trustees, volunteers from the local community.

The Wodonga Cemetery is self funded and relies on the income it receives from the services provided, which include burials, ashes interments and provisions for placement of memorial plaques.

These funds are invested directly back into the operation and maintenance of the cemetery with a portion of the funds Invested to ensure that the cemetery is maintained into perpetuity.



Interring Ashes

To ensure the life of your loved one is remembered for future generations we encourage you to consider establishing a permanent memorial in one of our Ashes Gardens. A memorial will provide a permanent location for family and friends to visit, commemorate, and celebrate your loved one and reflect on their life and memory.

Various locations are available for Ashes Interments, whether the Niche Wall, Burgundy Rose Garden, Flagpole Garden, Rose Garden, Memorial Garden, or in a private grave where a family member is already interred.

An Ashes Interment can involve the family and friends gathering at the plot, while others may choose an intimate or informal interment, or the interment can be performed by our cemetery staff without anyone present.

The interment can be close to the funeral or months or years later, or on a significant date. There is no rush, so you have time to find a date that is suitable. This gives mourners an outlet to grieve and a feeling of closure.
